**THE DIVISION’S NOTICE OF
 INTENT TO PROMULGATE
 REGULATIONS**

1 Defendant, Sandy O’Laughlin, in her official capacity as Commissioner of the State
2 of Nevada Department of Business and Industry, Financial Institutions Division (unless
3 noted otherwise, **the Division**), by and through counsel, provides notice of the Division’s
4 intent to promulgate regulations implementing SB 248.

5 Pursuant to the Court’s request (ECF No. 29), the Division notifies the Court of the
6 following schedule that the Division intends to follow in promulgating regulations:

7 1. The Division intends to have draft regulations within 2 weeks of August 10,
8 2021: **August 24, 2021.**

9 2. The Division will then draft a small business impact survey and send to all
10 interested parties within 2 weeks of August 24, 2021: **September 7, 2021.** (Small
11 businesses have 10 days to respond to the survey- Due by **September 17, 2021**)

12 3. The Division will then draft a small business impact statement from
13 comments received from small businesses within 3 weeks of September 17, 2021: **October**
14 **8, 2021.**

15 4. The Division will then conduct a workshop on the draft regulations, which will
16 be done with at least 15 days’ notice of October 8, 2021: **October 26,2021.**

17 5. Should a second workshop be necessary based on changes resulting from the
18 prior workshop that subsequent workshop will occur no later than 30 days from October
19 26, 2021: **November 24, 2021**

20 5. The draft regulations will then be sent to Nevada’s Legislative Counsel
21 Bureau for their review to ensure that the draft regulations conform to the drafting rules
22 for regulations in Nevada. This process may take the Legislative Counsel Bureau
23 anywhere between 30-60 days: **no deadline for the Legislative Counsel Bureau to**
24 **complete its review of the draft regulations.**

25 6. Once the Legislative Counsel Bureau returns the draft regulations to the
26 Division, the Division will publish public notice of an adoption hearing on **30 days’ notice.**

27 7. If the regulations are adopted by the Division, the adopted regulations are
28 then required to be sent to the Nevada Legislative Commission for its review. NRS

1 233B.067(1). If the Legislative Commission approves the permanent regulations adopted
2 by the Division, the Legislative Counsel shall “promptly” file them with the Nevada
3 Secretary of State. NRS 233B.067(5). **There is no deadline for the Nevada Legislative**
4 **Commission to complete its review of the draft regulations.**
